**Barrington Stage Company**, (BSC) is a professional, award-winning Equity theatre located in the Berkshires of Western MA, presenting top-notch musicals, masterful classics, thought-provoking plays, cabarets and youth theatre. Co-founded in 1995 by Artistic Director Julianne Boyd, BSC was voted Best Theatre by The Berkshire Eagle readers and is well-known as a center for the development and production of new work. Barrington Stage garnered national attention in 2004, when it premiered William Finn and Rachel Sheinkin's musical hit *The 25 Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee*, which later transferred to Broadway where it won two Tony Awards. BSC's all-time record breaking musical, *On the Town*, originally presented at BSC in 2013, is currently running on Broadway with BSC as a co-producer.
