Located at Fordham University in New York City, the NSLC on Theater is a 9-day conference providing talented high school students from around the globe with hands on theater experience. Students are immersed in the world of professional theater as they view award-winning shows and participate in workshops, master classes, and panels featuring professional actors, directors, designers, and stage managers. In addition, students have a unique opportunity to test their skills as they devise, rehearse, and perform their very own production.

#### The Role of the Team Advisor

Team Advisors (TAs) act as facilitators, presenters, simulation monitors, and resident advisors. The job of a TA encompasses the role of a chaperone, teacher, mentor, and policy enforcer. As a TA, you will supervise a group of 12-15 students, lead group discussions, teach academic and leadership sessions, facilitate the final student simulation, and serve as chaperone for off-campus trips. Working with your TA group is an amazing experience as you watch your students make friends for life and experience the world of Theater in a personal way. This is a unique opportunity to serve as a mentor and role model for talented young students and share your passion for and knowledge of Theater. Team Advisors arrive on-site 3-4 days before students arrive in order to participate in staff orientation/training and stay for both 9-day sessions.

#### Requirements for Employment

Team Advisors must be current college students or recent college graduates with a background and interest in some discipline of Theater. The most qualified candidates will have participated in leadership programs, workshops, or classes and will have experience working at summer camps or with high school students in a position of leadership. The NSLC is looking for TAs who are interested in and have experience in a variety of fields including acting, directing, technical theatre, film, or other performance-related fields.

#### Dates & Compensation

Team Advisors will be paid \$765 at the end of each session. The NSLC pays for room & board, as well as transportation to and from the conference. The 2018 dates for the National Student Leadership Conference on Theater are as follows:

They also participate in a rigorous and exciting two-week conservatory-style schedule, attending classes, and gaining personal feedback from some of the best professors in the business. Finally, students have a unique opportunity to test their skills as they devise, rehearse, and perform their very own production.

#### **The Role of the Team Advisor**

Team Advisors (TAs) act as facilitators, presenters, simulation monitors, and resident advisors. The job of a TA encompasses the role of a chaperone, teacher, mentor, and policy enforcer. As a TA, you will supervise a group of 12-15 students, lead group discussions, teach academic and leadership sessions, facilitate the final student simulation, and serve as chaperone for off-campus trips. Working with your TA group is an amazing experience as you watch your students make friends for life and experience the world of Acting and Theater in a personal way. Team Advisors arrive on-site 3-4 days before students arrive in order to participate in staff orientation/training and stay for an 18-day session.

The most qualified candidates will have participated in leadership programs, workshops, or classes and will have experience working at summer camps or with high school students in a position of leadership. The NSLC is looking for TAs who are interested in and have experience in a variety of fields including acting, directing, technical theatre, film, or other performance-related fields.

#### **Dates & Compensation**

Team Advisors will be paid \$1,530 at the end of the session. The NSLC pays for room & board, as well as transportation to and from the conference. The 2018 dates for the National Student Leadership Conference Acting Intensive Program are **July 18th - August 4th** and the conference will be held at Yale University, New Haven, CT.
