
November 15th, 2019: The application opens, and you may submit your application at any time.


ABOUT

ARTS ADMINISTRATION

Artist Services and Development

The Yard's two Arts Administration Interns will work closely with the organization's Artist Services and Development departments to ensure the success of the YARD ARTS Summer Season. They will assist in the day-to-day operations and management of The Yard, gaining hands-on experience in the field of arts administration. They will play an integral role in communications and external relations, facilitating artists' visits, and planning special events throughout the summer. One Arts Administration Intern will focus more on Artist Services, while the other will focus more on Development; both interns will gain cross-departmental experience.

MARKETING

The Yard's Marketing Intern will work with The Yard's Marketing team to craft social media campaigns as well as market The Yard's summer season performances. The ideal Marketing Intern is a marketing strategist, social media guru, and brand identity strategist. The Marketing Intern plays an integral role to bringing audiences to The Yard.


VIDEO PRODUCTION

The Yard's Video Production Intern will document the YARD ART summer season performances and activities through video. Additionally, the Video Production Intern will also have the opportunities to make sizzling promotional videos and work on video-centric marketing campaigns. The videos the Video Production Intern creates are an important document to help support artists, promote The Yard, and communicate the unique charm of The Yard's campus.

TECHNICAL PRODUCTION

The Technical Production Interns work closely with the Production Manager & Lighting Designer and the Assistant Production Manager on every event of the YARD ARTS summer season. After helping to open the theater for the season, the Technical Production Interns are responsible for the week-to-week upkeep and running of The Yard's mainstage theater (the Patricia N. Nanon blackbox - 100 seats), The Yard's open-air barn studio, and for select events: the Martha's Vineyard Performing Arts Center (Proscenium - 700 seats) and multiple offsite site-specific productions (annual benefit, pop up performances, art galleries, libraries, etc). Weekly responsibilities include: lighting hang and focus, sound hang and focus, programming and running shows, and assisting with the load-in and load-out of all artists and productions.
