

Spain Today: Madrid, Pamplona, Barcelona

(Summer program in Spain totaling 6-credits of Spanish)

- Courses/Credits: **6 credits: Span 565 or 772, and 569**

OVERVIEW:

This 4.5 week study tour will promote a critical understanding of the historical, political, social, and cultural forces that have shaped the Spanish nation. The Spanish classroom will be based at the Universidad de Navarra, but expand to include Spain's small towns, urban centers, museums, architectural, historical landmarks.

- **Madrid:** We will spend the first 3 days visiting the Prado museum, Retiro Park, and exploring Madrid's historic *casco antiguo* and bustling *Puerta del Sol*.
- **Pamplona:** For 4 weeks you will study at the Universidad de Navarra, in historic Pamplona (famous for the *running of the bulls*). Group day trips include **Burgos, Logroño, Valle de Baztán, Olite, Bilbao, San Sebastian, and San Juan de Gaztelugatxe** (#GOT #Dragonston). We'll walk a portion of the *Camino de Santiago*, leaving Pamplona and arriving in a neighboring village. Lodging in individual rooms with private bath in a centrally-located student resident hall, within walking distance to the University, historic center, and shopping district. You will depart Pamplona June 29, for your preferred airport.

PROGRAM COSTS (total **estimated** cost: ~\$6,500 + **airfare** and post-June 30 Covid-contingency funds):

-Program + K-State Tuition and Fees (Billed to K SIS for summer semester): *estimated ~\$6,500 (includes ALL lodging/accommodations/meals, all events/tours/admissions, in-country transportation, international health insurance, and 6 total credit hours: 3-credit course and use of all resources at Univ. of Navarra, and 3-credit course via K-State with Dr. Bender)*

-Airfare (students arrange their own flights and travel plan): **\$2,500** (*international airfare estimated at \$1,600 from MCI; optional expenses like phone plan, passport, and \$500 for Covid-test prior to US return and funds in case of positive test*).
